The Festival of the Horse Challenge.

Junior Challenge 90 - for teams of four junior riders and individuals.

Junior Challenge 100 - for teams of four junior riders and individuals.

Junior Pairs Challenge 90 - for pairs made up of any combination of Junior Challenge 90 or 100 competitors.

Senior Challenge 90 - for teams of four senior riders and individuals.

Senior Challenge 100 - for teams of four senior riders and individuals.

Senior Pairs Challenge 90 - for pairs made up of any combination of Senior Challenge 90 or 100 competitors.

NB. Classes will not be run in this order.

Full rules of this competition can be found on pages 59 - 63 of the BRC Official Rules 2014.

The course will consist of 7 - 10 show jumps followed by 15 - 25 cross-country fences, which may include up to 2 dressing fences in the Junior and Senior Pairs Challenge 90. There will only be a wait of up to 1 min. from finishing the show jumping to starting the cross-country course.

- All of the team competitions are for teams of 4, with the best 3 scores to count.
- The top individual that is not part of the qualifying team(s) will qualify for the championship.
- Junior riders must be under 18 on the 1st January 2014.
- Rosettes will be awarded to the first 6 teams and first 6 individuals.

Space permitting: we will also run a separate competition for individuals who do not wish to be part of the qualifying competition. Therefore riders who are not members of BRC or a BRC affiliated Club or who come from outside Area 10 will be welcome. Entries for this competition must be submitted on an [Ardingly Riding Club Entry Form](#) and not on the British Riding Club Entry Form. Rosettes will be awarded to 6th place and prize money given according to entries.

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES:

SATURDAY 19TH APRIL 2014.

Late entries will not be accepted and no entries will be accepted over the telephone. All team, pairs & individual entries for the qualifying competition must be made on the BRC official entry form.

A preliminary entry must have been received by the British Riding Clubs Office at least 21 days before the competition, (5th April 2014), to be eligible to qualify. Individuals not wishing to be part of the qualifying competition must use an [Ardingly Riding Club entry form](#) and no preliminary entry to BRC needs to be made. Entry forms can be downloaded from the British Riding Clubs website: www.britishridingclubs.org.uk Festival of the Horse, or the Ardingly Riding Club website: www.ridingclub.org.uk. They are also included at the end of this schedule.

Helpers:

Any club entering a team (junior or senior) **must** provide **two helpers for each team**, (not two helpers per club), able to help for the entire day. Helpers contact details, including mobile phone number & email, to be provided with the Area Entry Form. **Teams failing to provide helpers on the day will not be able to compete.**

Withdrawals/Team Changes: Should be made by email before Thursday 24th April and thereafter on the day.

Starting Times: Times will be published on the Ardingly Riding Club website: www.ridingclub.org.uk and the Area 10 web site: www.brcarea10.org.uk on Friday 25th April.

Equine Influenza Certificate: All competitors in the British Riding Club Qualifiers must have an up to date Equine Influenza Certificate, which must, under penalty of elimination, accompany the horse to this competition and the competitor is responsible for producing it on demand. **For all those horses not on the area database, a photocopy must be sent to the Entries Secretary with the Official Entry Form.**

General Rules & Conditions of Entry To be run under BRC Official Rules 2014

1. All entries are accepted only upon the terms of the general rules and conditions below. Your signature on the entry form shall be deemed to be an acceptance of the rules and conditions.
2. The judges' decisions are final.
3. **Health & Safety** – The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
4. **Disclaimer of Liability** – Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the British Horse Society, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles, land or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
5. **Protective Headgear** - Everyone mounted, whether competing or not, must wear a hard hat with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination. Hats must be marked BSEN 1384 (1997 or 2012), PAS015 (1998 or 2011), EN1384 (1996), provided they are BSI Kite marked; ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a), and have the SEI mark; SNELL E2001 and have the Snell label & number; AS/NZS3838 (2006) and have the SAI global mark. Where the hat is of skull cap style, this must be worn with a cover. **Hats must be tagged before riding.**
6. **Body Protectors** – A BETA Level 3 (Purple Label) protector, which has been manufactured in the year 2000 or after must be worn. An Air jacket worn over a level 3 protector is permitted, as are Hybrid Air Jackets and Exo Body Cage so long as the organiser has been informed about the wearing of the Exo Body Cage.
7. All lorries and trailers must be parked in an orderly fashion in the designated parking areas only and the gate to the lorry park kept closed. Do not muck out your box in the lorry park.
8. All dogs must be kept on leads.
