RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 No responsibility is accepted for anything that may happen from any cause whatsoever to competitors, spectators, horses, vehicles or property. It is a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the organisers & property owners against legal action arising from accident. Competitors enter at their own risk.
- 2 CLASS TIMES: Every effort will be made to run the Show to time but competitors & exhibitors are asked to note that times shown ARE A GUIDE ONLY. "Not Before" times will be adhered to. Check the HDRC Facebook page on the day for regular class updates. The organisers cannot be held responsible should classes overrun
- 3 The organisers have the right to alter classes and/or change judges if this should become necessary, without due warning
- 4 No entry fees will be returned except (a) on production of a current veterinary or doctor's certificate or (b) due to cancellation caused by the weather or unforeseen circumstances. In these instances entries will be returned less £3 for administration on receipt of SAE within 10 days of the show date. If the weather is bad please watch website www.hdrc.org.uk for up-to-date information
- 5 Judge's decision is final. Written objection to be made to Hon. Secretary's office together with £20 deposit within 15 minutes of end of class concerned being judged. If objection is sustained the deposit will be refunded otherwise it will be forfeited
- 6 No horse/pony under 4 years to be entered in any ridden class. No substitution entry permitted without Hon. Secretary's permission
- 7 All horses, ponies and dogs to be kept under proper control at all times.
DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A SHORT LEAD
- 8 HATS to current BSI standard PAS015, BSEN1384, ASTM F1163, AS/NZ 3838, VG1, SEI or SNELL E2001, securely fastened, must be worn at **all** times when mounted. Alternate hats for adult side saddle riders (see p.17) worn at competitors own risk. Competitors must wear correct riding attire. Body protectors are recommended.
- 9 Special Rosette awarded to highest placed Horsham & Dist. Riding Club member in each class. NB: 2016 membership number must be shown on the entry form
- 10 PRIZES In classes with 4 or more competitors a 1st prize of £10 **or** sponsor's own awards will be presented. Rosettes to 6th place. Sashes to all Champions.
- 11 TROPHIES to class winners. All are Perpetual Challenge Trophies. All must be signed for and returned CLEAN on request. Engraving is at winners expense
- 12 SHOWING CLASSES limited to first 25 entries. SHOW JUMPING classes limited to first 35 entries and judged according to BS rules. PRACTICE JUMPS must be jumped from correct side - red on right. Failure to do so may result in elimination.

(BSPA) BRITISH SKEWBALD & PIEBALD ASSOCIATION Classes 2-3 & 15-16 are open to **skewbald & piebald** horses & ponies ONLY. These classes are affiliated to the BSPA and are qualifiers for the BSPA World of Colour Championship Show on 10th Sept. 2016 at The College EC, Keysoe, Beds. The classes will be judged within BSPA rules and criteria - details from 01354 638226 or download from www.bsponline.com All stallions 4 years & over must be graded, licensed & registered with BSPA in order to compete and must carry into the ring their red BSPA showing ID card + BSPA bridle discs to be worn. **These classes are open to Members AND non members** but in order to qualify all owners/handlers & riders must be members of the BSPA and all horses/ponies registered with BSPA prior to this show. **Qualification 1st-3rd in all classes or 1st-4th in those exceeding 10 entries.** BSPA qualification cards must be produced in the ring and signed by the judge otherwise qualification is invalid. The highest placed Amateur and highest placed Junior in each class (BSPA members) will qualify for the Amateur and Junior Supreme Championship Finals at Keysoe. Silk hats are permitted to be worn in this class at any time of the day at rider's own risk. Judge is requested to use mark sheet provided. '*San Suave Prince*' Challenge Salver to winner who is eligible for the Supreme Championship

Highest placed horse/rider combination qualify for Final at the National Side Saddle Show 5/7th August. In the event of previous qualification this may be passed down to 4th place. **Sp.rosettes** are offered by **Mrs T Mitchell** to the winner. If the winner has already qualified a second rosette is awarded with the Qualification Card. Qualifying combinations are required to become Full members of SSA 21 days prior to National Side Saddle Show or as soon as possible if qualified after that date to be eligible to compete at the Final.
