COMPETITION RULES

- Dressage under BD Rules. Judges decision is final.
- NO telephone entries accepted. NO entry accepted without fee. Late entries taken if classes not full; at £1.00 extra per horse per class.
- Neither the organiser, nor any person acting on their behalf, accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- The organiser of this event has taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser, officials and stewards.
- Protective headgear must be worn at ALL times by ALL persons mounted.
- Correct Riding wear must be worn by competitors. Failure to do so may result in prize money being withheld. Dressage riders may be dismounted for prize giving.
- Misuse of whips, equipment or saddlery will be reported to the BHS.
- Objections, with deposit of £10.00, must be made in writing to Secretary within 15 minutes of incident. Deposit will be forfeited if objection not upheld.
- No entry fee will be refunded without the production of a veterinary or doctor's certificate.
- In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be refunded excluding £3.00 to cover expenses; on submission of SAE, within 10 days of the cancelled date.
- Please take your litter and horse manure home with you.
- **NO DOGS ON SHOW GROUND PLEASE.**
- Classes may be altered at discretion of the organisers.

RIDDEN CLASSES - continued

12 BSPA / EQUIFEST RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD

Open ridden Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championship. Subject to their show rules & conditions. Classes may be divided according to entries.

13 BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES/EQUIFEST RIDDEN HUNTERS

Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cms. Riders any age.

Classes may be divided as follows:

Lightweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying up to 12.7 stone.

Middleweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying 12.7 stone but not 14 stone.

Heavyweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over capable of carrying over 14 stone.

14 OPEN RIDDEN CLASS

Open to horses and ponies 4 years and over

15 VETERAN HORSE AND PONY

15 years and over special rosette to best over 20

7 NOVICE RIDDEN

Horse never to have been placed 1st in any ridden class

8 RIDING CLUB HORSE

Snaffle bridle may be asked to jump a small jump

9 NUPAFED / EQUIFEST RIDING HORSES

Open Riding Horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height.

Riders any age.

Classes may be divided as follows:

Small Riding Horses - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.

Large Riding Horses - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.

10 NUPAFED / EQUIFEST RIDDEN COBS

Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. Riders any age.

Classes may be divided as follows:

Open Lightweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.

Open Heavyweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.

NUPAFEDS COBS not exceeding 15.1hh 4 years and over

11 HAYGAIN /EQUIFEST MAXI COBS

Open Maxi Cobs, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 155cms – to be judged as Cobs. Riders any age.

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective pure breed societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A,B,C & D. Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years old & over. Rider any age.

6 RETRAINED RACEHORSES

For registered ROR horses. Class may be divided into flat horses and jump horses.
